Most of our summer programs require online signups. In general, registration opens two weeks before each event. Scan here for more details and all program registrations









Come build with Legos at the library. For children in kindergarten and older. Sign-ups are required.






ARTIST & AUTHOR VISITS


Meet Star the Therapy Pony Tues, June 24 at 6 pm

Come to this exciting live animal presentation! From an engaging speaker, learn how to protect wildlife. For children of all ages. Registration is required.




