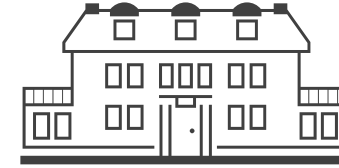

Most of our summer programs require online signups. In general, registration opens two weeks before each event. Scan here for more details and all program registrations



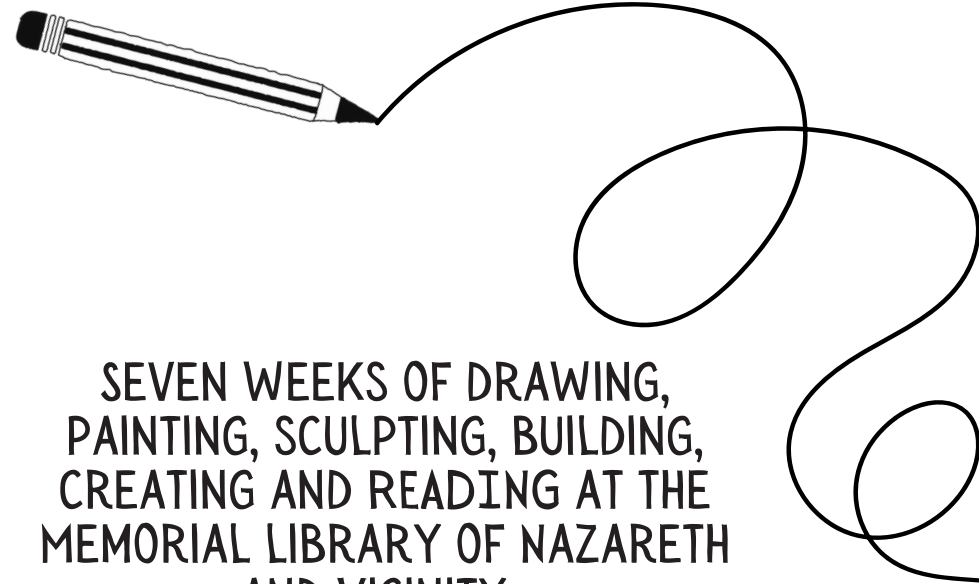

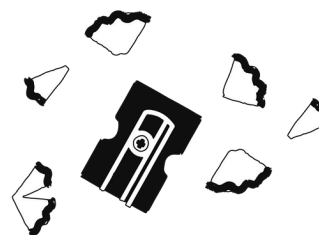

## WILD MART & WILD BUCKS

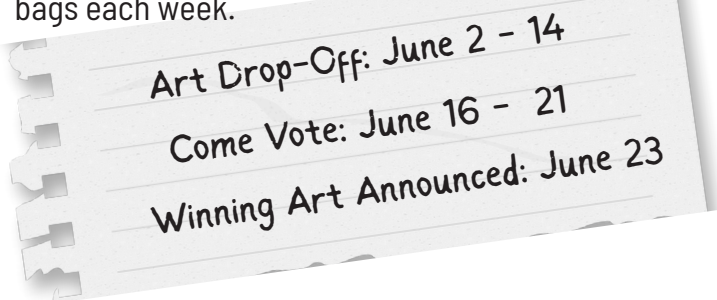

## ARTIST & AUTHOR VISITS

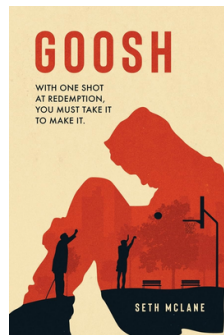
### Meet Artist & Author Kevin McCloskey Fri, June 20 at 2 pm

Come meet the author of the middle grade book *Goosh*. For children in third grade and older. Sign-ups are required.



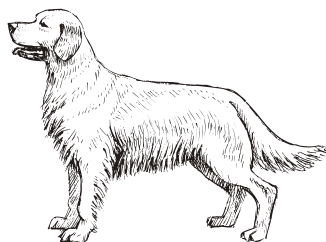
## ANIMAL ENCOUNTERS

Come meet Star, a working therapy pony. For kids of all ages, registration is required.

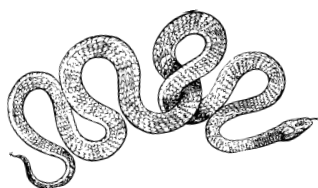
### Read to the Pups with the Seeing Eye Tues, July 15 and July 22 at 6 pm

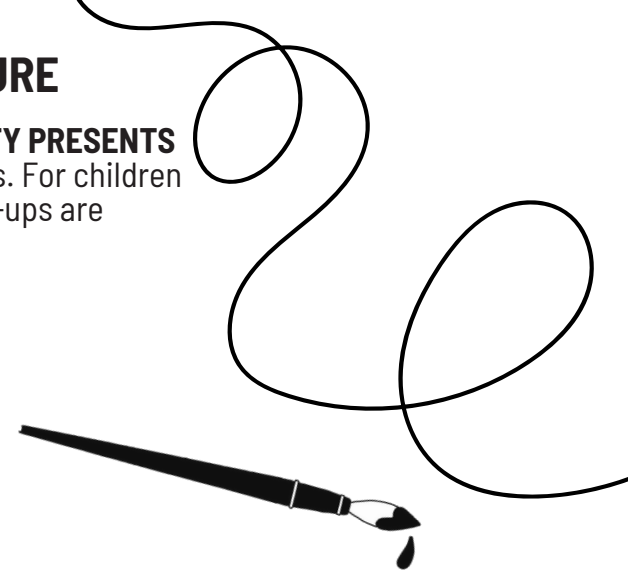
